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Why?	Financial companies choose how they share your personal information. Federal law gives consumers the right to limit some but not all sharing. Federal law also requires us to tell you how we collect, share, and protect your personal information. Please read this notice carefully to understand what we do.
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What?	<p>The types of personal information we collect and share depend on the product or service you have with us. 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How?	All financial companies need to share customer's personal information to run their everyday business. In the section below, we list the reasons financial companies can share their customer's personal information; the reasons Connecticut Community Bank, N.A. chooses to share; and whether you can limit this sharing.

These measures include computer safeguards and secured files and buildings. We limit access to your personal information to employees who need to know that information, they are educated on the importance of confidentiality, customer privacy and safeguarding information.

Why can't I limit all sharing?	<p>Federal law gives you the right to limit only</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <input type="checkbox"/> Sharing for affiliates' everyday business purposes — information about your creditworthiness <input type="checkbox"/> Affiliates from using your information to market to you <input type="checkbox"/> Sharing for non-affiliates to market to you <p>State laws and individual companies may give you additional rights to limit sharing.</p>

Definitions	
Affiliates	<p>Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <input type="checkbox"/> <i>Connecticut Community Bank, N.A. does not have affiliates.</i>
Non-affiliates	<p>Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <input type="checkbox"/> <i>Connecticut Community Bank, N.A. does not share with non-affiliates so they can market to you.</i>
Joint marketing	<p>A formal agreement between nonaffiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <input type="checkbox"/> Our joint marketing partners include financial service providers.
